

Additions to the **Aurora & Marmo** and **Terrazzo** families are joined by a newly defined **Calacatta collection**, bringing together marble-inspired surfaces that combine visual elegance with the practical benefits of a non-porous, thermoformable material.

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Terrazzo With a Twist:



New to this popular contemporary effect that's inspired by a traditional heavily-grained aesthetic are five versatile tones ideal for a wide variety of uses and settings. Four of these contain SCS-certified pre-consumer recycled content and are well-suited to high-traffic applications: **Terrazzo Ulivo** is a densely speckled shade against a background with a suggestion of olive tones, **Terrazzo Nuvola** is a delicious nougat shade with warm tones and flecks of red, **Terrazzo Sorrento** is a paler option with a matrix of pastel grains and a lemony tone for the region after which it is named, **Terrazzo Marsala** is a cool and subtle choice with red wine tones that's ideal for harmonising with greys and beiges. Completing the range, **Terrazzo Selva** delivers a darker, more dramatic option with a dense constellation of lighter grains.

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Cool Calacatta:


Calacatta Vista, **Calacatta Desert Moon** and **Calacatta Lake Moon** join the three existing Calacatta shades to create a new HIMACS family capturing all the timeless elegance of this luxurious marble aesthetic in a robust, non-porous and malleable form. **Calacatta Vista** offers the palest whisper of veining against a discreet, milky background, while **Calacatta Desert Moon** offers creamy and warm tones and **Calacatta Lake Moon** is an ethereal, semi-translucent option with all the charm of alabaster – and like every HIMACS option, all the versatility of a thermoformable surface.

Going Green:

Both are ideal for sleek, easy-care decorative applications.

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Amazing Auroras:



Expanding fabrication possibilities further, **Aurora Alps** is now available in an extra-wide **1520 mm sheet**, enabling larger, more seamless surfaces.

It is widely used for architectural and interior applications, such as sculptural and high-performance wall cladding or kitchen, bathroom and furniture surfaces, in commercial, residential and public space projects. It is composed of minerals, acrylic and natural pigments that come together to provide a smooth, non-porous and visually seamless surface which meets the highest standards for quality, aesthetics, fabrication, functionality and hygiene – offering many advantages over conventional materials.

HIMACS provides limitless possibilities for surfacing solutions and inspires creative minds from all over the world. **Zaha Hadid, Jean Nouvel, Rafael Moneo, Karim Rashid, Marcel Wanders** and **David Chipperfield**, among others, have completed fabulous projects using HIMACS.

Proud to be at the forefront of innovation, LX Hausys made Solid Surface history with the introduction of **HIMACS Ultra-Thermoforming**, a pioneering formulation which pushes the boundaries of solid surface shaping to significant new levels with 30% greater thermoplastic capability. Furthermore, **HIMACS Intense Ultra** is a groundbreaking advance that now combines the qualities of both **Intense Colour Technology** and **Ultra-Thermoforming**.

To add to the benefits of working with HIMACS, now the iconic HIMACS Alpine White, plus a wide selection of colours, come with SCS certified pre-consumer recycled content for a more sustainable product offering.

HIMACS uses a simple heating process to give three-dimensional thermoplastic forming capabilities, allows visually seamless designs, offers a virtually limitless range of colours and – for some shades – exhibits a special translucency when exposed to light. Although HIMACS is almost as robust as stone, it can be worked in a similar way as wood: it can be sawn, routed, drilled or sanded.

HIMACS is made using a next-generation technology, the **thermal cure**. The temperature reached during the manufacturing process sets HIMACS apart from other solid surfaces and creates a denser surface that is even sturdier, more homogeneous and more durable, and with better resistance and superior thermoforming results.

HIMACS does not absorb humidity, is highly resistant to stains and is easy to clean, maintain and repair. HIMACS is composed from premium-quality materials, ensuring a surface that is free from harmful substances such as silica, formaldehyde, VOC emissions, and nanoparticles. Prioritising health and safety, HIMACS offers peace of mind for any environment.

Countless internationally recognised certificates attest to the quality of HIMACS in terms of ecological commitment, hygiene and fire resistance – being the first Solid Surface in the market to receive the official **European Technical Approval (ETA) for façades** – for the Alpine White S728 colour.
